**GOAL:** To know that anything can happen in my life because of the power of the gospel.

**GET GOING:**

1. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 again. What stands out to you in this passage? How would you define the gospel based on this passage?

2. The truth of the gospel makes anything possible in your life. What reasons from the message stand out to you and why?

3. The gospel is believable. Who, in your circle of influence, needs to *believe* the gospel?

**BONUS THOUGHT:**

1 Corinthians was one of the earliest letters written by Paul, probably around 55 AD. This means a clear and robust definition of the gospel was being taught extremely close to the life and ministry of Jesus.

**MEMORY VERSE:**

"For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures" (2 Corinthians 15:3).

**KEEP GROWING**

4. Read verses 9-10 again. Jesus converted Paul, who persecuted Christians to the point of death, yet God used him to reach countless people for the gospel. *No one is too far from God's grace.* Is there anything you've done in your life that you think is irredeemable? Is there anything holding you back from fully surrendering to God's will and believing that anything is possible in your life?

5. As Paul wrote, the gospel was given to him to be passed on. The gospel was given to you, not only to save you, but so that you can share it with others. With whom in your life do you need to share the gospel?

**BONUS CHALLENGE:**
