VALUE #1: LOVE GOD

Passage: Deuteronomy 6:1-9

GOAL:

To think through and establish the values and biblical principles we are building our families upon.

GET GOING:

- Have you ever written family values? If so, what are they? If not, take some time to brainstorm a couple of ideas.
- In reality, what values, whether clearly stated or not, are you actually building your family upon?
- What does loving God practically look like in your daily living?
- Read Deuteronomy 6:2 again. What do you think it means to “fear the Lord”?

Memory Verse: “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might” (Deuteronomy 6:5).



KEEP GROWING:

- Throughout Deuteronomy there are several other instances of commands to love God with all of our heart and soul. Deuteronomy 6:5 is the only reference that includes the word “might.” When Jesus quotes this verse thousands of years later (Luke 10:27) he also adds “and with all your strength, and with all your mind.” What does it look like to love God with all your...
 - Heart
 - Soul
 - Might
 - Strength
 - Mind
- Loving God requires obedience (John 14:15). Biblical obedience means doing **W**hat God wants, **W**hen He wants it done, and **W**ith a God-honoring attitude. Take some time to think about a recent situation where you needed to obey God’s leading. Did you do what God wanted? Did you wait, or do it when He wanted it done? Did you do it with a good attitude? How can you grow in your obedience and love for God?
- Deuteronomy 6:7 says we are to teach God’s commands to our children diligently; to pass the faith on to the next generation. If you have kids, what can you practically do to teach them truths about God? If you don’t have kids, or your kids are grown and out of the house, your job isn’t done! To whom can you be teaching God’s truths, to pass the faith on the next spiritual generation?
