GOAL:

To understand our responsibility as followers of Christ to imitate Him and make disciples.

GET GOING:

- Since Jesus is not physically with us now, how can we fulfill our call to observe and imitate Him?
- In your own words, why is the biblical pattern belief, then baptism?
- Review the 4 Stages of Divine Discipleship that were shared this weekend. In what stage do you find yourself? How can you progress to the next stage?
 - The call to observe (John 1:39)
 - The call to follow (Matt 4:19; Mark 1:17)
 - The call to imitate (Mark 6:7-13; Luke 9:1-6; Matt 10:5-15)
 - The command to reproduce (Matt 28:19-20)

MEMORY VERSE:

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age” (Matthew 28:19-20).



KEEP GROWING:

- The 4 Stages of Divine Discipleship are a cycle. When we reach the point of reproducing, we need to keep observing, following and imitating. Have you ever multiplied yourself in someone else by making disciples? How can you keep the cycle going?
- Jesus disciplined 12 guys who disciplined others, and so on and so forth until today. Who shared the love of Jesus with you? And, who are you taking through the Discipleship Cycle now?
- There's a story of the disciples hearing Jesus' call to follow, and dropping their fishing nets immediately to follow Him (Mark 1:17-18). This weekend Pastor Ron shared 5 "Nets" that we may need to drop to follow Jesus. Review these. Can you resonate with any of these? How so?
 - The Net of Comfort
 - The Net of Complacency
 - The Net of Compromise
 - The Net of Carnality
 - The Net of Conformity
