Passage: Acts 13-14 (and 16)

GOAL:

To meet people where they're at, and point them to Jesus.

GET GOING:

- In one or two sentences, how would you summarize the main point of this weekend's message?
- What's been your experience with sharing your faith? How have you observed other people sharing their faith? What's been effective, and what's been ineffective?
- Sharing your faith requires knowing God's Word. How well do you know your Bible? Have you ever read it all the way through? What typically holds you back from going deeper into God's Word?
- This is Holy Week. If we remember what Jesus did for us in dying on the cross on "Good Friday," why do we call it good?

BONUS THOUGHT: Before the term "Christian" was coined, people who believed in Jesus were called "Followers of The Way."



KEEP GROWING:

- Paul's pattern to share the gospel with people was to present it differently based on people's background. He built a bridge from what people knew, met them where they were at, and led them to Jesus. Is this how you think about sharing your faith? How can you more effectively meet people where they are and ultimately point them to Jesus?
- Who in your life could you approach differently, trying to model Paul's pattern of meeting people where they're at? What name comes to mind? What would you do differently?
- What would you say to someone who has had a bad experience with the Church, Christians, and/or Christianity?

BONUS CHALLENGE:

Next Sunday is Easter, where we will celebrate the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. We've been challenging you, "Who's Your One?" Who is the one person God is leading you to invite to Easter at Highpoint? If you haven't already, pray about and invite the one whom God is placing on your heart.
