### What I Learned

- A power cord can give our devices power, but God's powerful love makes us strong.
- In Sunday's Bible story, we saw how *God's Love is Powerful*. Lazarus had died, and his sisters and Jesus were sad. But Jesus showed how powerful He is when He brought Lazarus back to life. God's love is powerful!
- With that kind of power, we can know that God's love is more powerful than anything! When things are going well—He's powerful. When things are hard—He's powerful. God's amazing love is more powerful than we can possibly imagine!

- What is something you learned or what stood out to you about God?

- Who can you tell about God this week?

# Go Deeper

- Read John 11:25-26. God's love is powerful enough to defeat anything! God loves
  us and is with us even in sad and hard times. How do you think Mary and Martha
  were different after Jesus raised their brother, Lazarus, from the dead?
- God's love can do the unimaginable, like when Jesus brought Lazarus back to life.
   Think about a time when things turned from bad to good in your life?
- How did you see God's power and love in that situation? Ask your family to share an example of how God's love did the unimaginable.

### Now What?

**Talk to God:** God has powerful love for us has no limit! There is no one more powerful than God and nothing more powerful than His love. What good news! He loves to listen to us when we talk to Him, which is called praying. Take time to thank Him for His unending love for us.
