What I Learned

- Elijah was a prophet, which means he was a person who would share special messages from God.
- Not everyone liked these messages, which means that not everyone liked Elijah.
- But even when things were hard, Elijah stood strong and continued to love and follow God. And God worked through Elijah to show others just how powerful God is.
- When we follow God and obey Him, even when things are scary or difficult, we can show others that God is amazing and powerful. God helps us stand strong

Get Talking

- Think about a time when you were faced with a choice and whether or not you were able to make the right one. How did it turn out? Was it hard to choose?
- This week talk about what obedience means and how we can obey God and make the right choice.

Go Deeper

Read 1 Kings 18:36-39

- Who are people you know or have heard about that have done really amazing things?
- God gives us strength to stand strong in Him, even when things are hard.
 What are some cool and amazing things that can happen when we stand strong for God?
- Elijah stood strong and God showed His amazing power to King Ahab and the prophets of Baal. He asked them to choose who they would serve, even though He knew they followed a false God. When do you think it might be hard for us to stand strong?

Now What?

Talk to God: The Bible tells us that we can stand strong. As we stand out in the world, we can remember that we are set apart, and that God is always with us. Take time to thank God for always being with us.

• God, thank You for this truth that we have learned today, that we are set apart and we can stand strong in You! We pray that You would help us remember who You say we are this week as we seek to stand out and live set apart through Your strength. Amen!

Memory Verse

Deuteronomy 7:6a

 This verse in Deuteronomy tells us how we are special people. We are God's special people because when we follow and trust in God, He gives us a new identity. He says we are His children, and that means He calls us holy, which means God sets us apart. When we trust Jesus, we can stand out!
