July 20, 2025 // 2 Samuel 11-12:14; Psalm 51

What I Learned

- This Sunday, we learned that God knows our actions. In 2 Samuel 11-12:14, King David made wrong choices that led to wrong actions that hurt several people.
- The prophet Nathan told David a story that helped David see that God knew all about his wrong actions. As a result, David wrote **Psalm 51,** confessing his need for forgiveness from God.
- We can better understand that God knows our actions as well, and He offers us forgiveness through Jesus for our sins.

Get Talking

Read 2 Samuel 11-12:14 and Psalm 51 and highlight Psalm 51:10-12 as a family.

- This week, take 1 day to ask these 2 questions and spend 3 minutes talking about them:
 - Do you think your actions matter, even if they don't hurt anyone else, and why do you think that?
 - Since God knows your actions and will always forgive you, what can you do when you make wrong choices?
- When we sin, we deserve God's punishment, which is separation from Him forever. But just like God forgave David, God offers forgiveness to us too! God sent His Son, Jesus, to die on the cross and then come back to life.

July Verse

"Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me." Psalm 51:10

 Nothing is hidden from God, even our actions that no one else may know about. This verse reminds us that that we are broken because of our sin, but because of Jesus, we can be made new.
