What I Learned

- This weekend, we learned that we can look out, stay faithful to follow God, and trust His purpose for their lives.
- In **Genesis 39-40**, a man named Joseph was faced with some difficult choices. He chose to follow God and do the right thing, even though it meant he was sent to prison.
- We can know that even when bad things happen, we can trust that He is with us, and He knows what is going to happen next. We can be willing to trust and follow Him in a way that helps people know more about Him.

Get Talking

Read **Genesis 39** as a family and highlight **Genesis 39:21-23**.

- This week, take **1 day** to ask these **2 questions** and spend **3 minutes** talking about them:
 - What do you do when you are faced with a tough choice?
 - How can you turn to God when you are faced with those kinds of choices?
- As you are out and about as a family, talk about the different traffic signs you all see. Share that trusting those signs help keep us safe and on track.
- Similarly, looking out, trusting, and following God helps us stay in line with His plan for us.

August Verse

“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.” **Ephesians 2:10**

- This Bible verse tells us that God has already prepared good things (or good works) for us to do. God designed us for a purpose—to love and follow Him and help others love and follow Him too. We can look out when we have tough choices to make and remember to keep following God and His purpose for our lives.
