September 14, 2025 // Mark 5:21-34

What I Learned

- This Sunday, we learned that "God Knows Everyone!" Jesus taught to a large crowd when a woman, who had been sick for 12 years, worked her way through the crowd—knowing that if she could just His clothes she would be healed. When the woman touched Jesus, she was healed.
- Jesus felt power leave Him and, even amidst all the people in the crowd, He saw and knew it was the woman who touched Him. He declared her faith made her well.
- We never have to worry if we blend into the crowd with Jesus because He sees us all and knows exactly what we need. Kids will learn that God knows them because God knows everyone!

Get Talking

Read Mark 5:21-34 and highlight Mark 5:30-34 as a family.

- This week, take 1 day to ask these 2 questions and spend 3 minutes talking about them:
 - Why do you think we matter to God?
 - Does knowing that God knows everyone encourage you to tell your friends that God knows them too?
- Talk this week about friends and family who might need to know that God knows them and loves them.
- Take time to pray for the people in their lives to know the truth about the love of God.

September Verse

"man looks on the outward appearance, but the Lord looks on the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7b

 This verse explains that God doesn't see people the way humans do. People often judge by appearances, but God looks at the heart. This means God cares more about what's inside a person their thoughts, feelings, and character - than what they look like on the outside
