What I Learned

Get Talking

 - Why is it difficult when bad things happen, even when you love God?
 - How can we trust that God's plan is always good?
- Talk this week about friends and family who might need to know that God knows them and loves them.
- Take time to pray for the people in their lives to know the truth about the love of God.
