Share: Get Talking

- What's the most "once-for-all" thing you've ever done? (Something you have done once and you never want to do again).
- What's one "reality" you discovered as an adult that no one warned you about? (Laundry, taxes, back pain at age 30...)

Study: Go Deeper

Read Hebrews 7:23-28, what insights or principles stood out to you as you studied the passage and heard it preached this week?

We Are Secured Eternally (Hebrews 7:23-24)

- Do you personally feel secure in your salvation? Why or why not?
- What do you think might be causing your fear, doubt, or insecurity spiritually—and how does Jesus' permanent priesthood speak into that?
- The text emphasized that priests "bring people to God." Where have you been trying to get to God through your own effort rather than through Christ?

We Are Saved Completely (Hebrews 7:25)

- What do you think "save to the uttermost" means in the context of this passage?
- How does Jesus' ongoing intercession deepen your understanding of salvation?

- Why is it significant that salvation is not partial, temporary, or fragile? How does that confidence change how we see/live our lives?
- Think about the phrase “no one is too far gone.” Who in your life seems unreachable? How can you pray for or reach out to them this season?
- What part of your own story still feels “beyond redemption”?
- The sermon challenged us to think about who we might pray for or invite during the holidays. Who is one person on your heart right now?

We Are Satisfied Fully (Hebrews 7:26-28)

- Look at the description of Jesus in v.26 — holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, exalted above the heavens. How do these qualities make Him the perfect High Priest?
- Where do you still seek satisfaction apart from Jesus—approval, comfort, success, entertainment, relationships, etc.?
- What does it look like for you to “enjoy God now,” not just in eternity?
- Which of these realities do you struggle to believe the most:
 - That God accepts you fully?
 - That Jesus’ sacrifice is enough?
 - That Jesus is perfect forever and interceding for you?
