## Share: Get Talking

- What's one thing you've grown to appreciate more as you've gotten older?
- What's a time you gave great advice... but didn't follow it yourself?
- Are you more of a doomsday prepper or 'we will figure it out then' type of a person?

## Study: Go Deeper

Read Hebrews 12:18-29. Then Pray!

Ask: What word, phrase, or idea stood out to you? Why?

### 1. Draw Near with Confidence (vv. 18–24)

- What contrasts do you see between Mount Sinai (vv. 18–21) and Mount Zion (vv. 22–24)?
- How is the experience of Israel at Sinai described?
- Do you approach God more like Sinai (distance, fear, performance) or Zion (confidence, grace)?
- What keeps you from drawing near confidently?

### 2. Listen to His Voice with Humility (vv. 25–26)

- What warning is given in verse 25?
- What does the future “shaking” refer to?
- How does God speak today?
- Where is God currently prompting you through Scripture?
- Is there an area where you are hearing but not obeying?

### **3. Order Your Life with Wisdom (v. 27)**

- What cannot be shaken?
- Why does God allow shaking?
- What in your life would collapse if it were shaken?
- What needs to be reordered in your calendar, finances, or relationships?

### **4. Worship Genuinely with Reverence and Gratitude (vv. 28-29)**

- What are believers receiving?
- What does “acceptable worship” tangibly look like in the life of the believer?
- How do the descriptions of God and the correct posture toward Him found in V. 28-29 differ from many of the churches/Christians found today?
- Is your heart more marked by entitlement or gratitude?

### **Support: Grow Together**

- What are you thankful for most in your relationship with God right now?
- What do you find yourself clinging to in this life that will not last?
- How would firmly believing the Gospel change the way you live this week?
