This Week's Big Idea

Kindness notices people and goodness takes action.

Family Recap

Ruth was far from home and didn't have food to eat. Boaz noticed her, welcomed her, protected her, and even provided for her. Boaz didn't have to help Ruth, but he chose kindness and goodness because he followed God.

Family Devotion

It's easy to be kind to our friends. It's harder to notice people who may feel lonely, new, or left out. Boaz teaches us that kindness begins when we see others the way God sees them.

The Holy Spirit helps us look beyond ourselves and care for the people around us. Kindness isn't just being nice, it's choosing to do good for others.
