## How To Apply For Unemployment:

To apply for unemployment we recommend you file online for the quickest response.

- Apply if you have lost your job or hours due to covid-19. We strongly recommend you to apply even if you have been denied in the past.

- Filing days are assigned based on the first letter of your last name
  - **A-M** on Sundays, Tuesday's and Thursday's
  - **N-Z** is on Mon. Wed. and Friday.
  - Saturdays is only for individuals that are not able to file on their assigned day.

## Where can I get food and resources:

Our Mobile Drive Up Care Center is available for you. Come and receive a bag filled with groceries and resources all without getting out of your own vehicle. ## Questions about Housing:

- **Homeowners** - Contact your mortgage company or your landlord to see if there are deferment options due to COVID-19
- **Renters** - Governor J.B. Pritzker has issued an executive order pausing enforcement of residential evictions until April 10
- **Homeless** - Overnight shelter sites are temporarily closed due to COVID-19. If you are homeless **call 1-866-682-3846 ext. 2275** or [email streetoutreach@dupagepads.org](mailto:streetoutreach@dupagepads.org) for transportation to emergency housing.
- **Utilities** - The ICC required all private water, electric and natural gas utilities in Illinois to suspend shut-offs and waive late fees until May 1, 2020, or until the Governor announces the end of the COVID-19 state of public health emergency, should the state of emergency remain in effect past May 1, 2020.

## Is there a COVID19 stimulus package and how do I apply for it?

**What is it?** A one time check to provide financial assistance to American households affected by the coronavirus pandemic.

**Who is getting a check?** Individuals earning up to \$75,000 in adjusted gross income (the income on your tax return) and who has a Social Security number.

**How much will I get?** Most adults will get \$1,200. Married couples will receive \$2,400. Plus \$500 for every qualifying child age 16 or under. \*

\*The payment declines for individuals who make more, and phases out for those who earn more than \$99,000. For married couples the phase out starts at \$150,000 of income.

### What do I have to do to get a check?

For most people, nothing. The U.S. Treasury will direct deposit the money in your bank if they have that information from this year's tax return or last year's. For everyone else, they will mail a check. If you didn't file a tax return for either 2018 or 2019, your check could be delayed. The government can use your Social Security benefit statement as well.

**When will the payment arrive?** Treasury Secretary Steven Mnuchin [said](#) he expected most people to get their payments within three weeks. For more information on the Coronavirus Stimulus Package [CLICK HERE](#)
