Outline:

1. Share about a time when someone was generous toward you. How did their generosity affect you?

Study: Go Deeper

1. Read Luke 16:1-3. Why was the manager being fired? What did he fail to do?

2. Luke 16:8 says the manager was commended for his shrewdness. What is shrewdness and how can it be useful in building the Kingdom?

3. How does being faithful with a little lead to being faithful with a lot? How is our faithfulness impacted by having an eternal perspective?

4. Read Luke 16:13. What does serving money look like in someone's life? In your life? How can we use money to serve the Lord?

Support: Grow Together

1. Are the resources I have been given drawing me closer to God, or drawing me away from God?
2. On a scale of 1-10, self-assess how your leveraging the income and possessions God has given you to build His Kingdom. What does this display about your faith?
3. Where in my life is God leading me to take action in how I'm stewarding what He has entrusted me with?
